



Call for Entries: 2019 Virginia Artists Juried Exhibition

Exhibition Dates: **October 1 - November 23, 2019**

Submission Deadline: **Thursday, September 5th, 5pm**

Online submissions for the Hampton Arts **2019 Virginia Artists Juried Exhibition** at the Charles H. Taylor Visual Arts Center in Hampton, VA are now being accepted by all artists living in Virginia working in any media.

Eligibility: Virginia artists (ages 18 and over) are invited to submit up to three original artworks for consideration. Artworks created by the artist within the past two years and not previously shown at the Charles H. Taylor Visual Arts Center are eligible. All media, styles, techniques and subject matter are eligible. Works should not exceed 60" in any direction (including framing), or weigh more than 150lbs. Accepted artworks must be delivered dry and ready to hang and remain for the duration of the exhibition. (CHTVAC reserves the right to refuse artworks that do not meet installation requirements or are otherwise judged unsuitable).

Submission deadline is Thursday, **September 5th**.

The entry fee is \$35 (\$30 for current Hampton Arts League members) for up to three artworks.

About the Juror: Jeffrey W. Allison is the Paul Mellon Collection Educator and Manager of Statewide Programs and Exhibitions at the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts and a professional photographer. He holds a BA in photography from Virginia Intermont College and an MFA in photography and film from VCU. He has curated numerous exhibitions including Through Different Eyes: The Faces of Poverty in Virginia, Unbroken Circle: Unto the Generations, Egypt Through the Drawing Room: 19th Century Stereographs of Egypt, and, Faces at the Races: Equine Culture in Virginia; as well as the Paul Mellon Arts in Education exhibitions, They Call it Stormy Weather: How Artists View the Weather and the Seasons, and A Horse of Course! Equine Images in Art at VMFA, which are traveling to locations throughout the Commonwealth. He currently teaches Advanced Photography and the History of Photography at the VMFA and has taught for over thirty years at institutions including Virginia Intermont College, Virginia Commonwealth University, East Tennessee State University, the Visual Arts Center of Richmond, and Virginia Highlands Community College.

Awards: Best in Show (\$1500); David Levinson Photography Award (\$1000); Sandra & David Hillerson Memorial Award (\$500); First Place (\$1000); Second Place (\$750); Third Place (\$500); Realist Painting Award (\$500); Award of Excellence (\$500); Awards of Distinction (\$250 for each category) in Painting, Photography, Drawing, Printmaking, Sculpture, Mixed Media, Folk Art or Craft, and Watercolor.

Shipped artworks must be in reusable packaging and must include prepaid return shipping labels. Artist and title information must accompany each piece.

Artwork Sales: The sale price on your entries should include a 30% gallery commission. Works may be NFS. Hampton Arts will collect the 6% Virginia State Sales Tax on sales from the buyer at time of purchase.

Insurance: Artworks will be insured for the sales price (less 30% commission) from the time of delivery until the end of designated pick up dates.
